COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE
JANUARY 2018 REPORT

The Communications Committee discussed Deborah Hochbein's suggestion of having residents recommend home contractors and posting the recommendations in TT. We considered the questions of whether this would be considered a free ad or a service to our community, whether TT would be the correct forum and bearing in mind that Nextdoor Little Turtle -a daily digest - carries contractor recommendations and advertisements.

The Communications Committee recommends:

- (a) Posting the names of residents' recommended contractors on our website under "Rules and Regs/Maintenance Tips."*
- (b) An article would be placed in the next edition of TT requesting resident's recommendations of home contractors and advising the location on our website IF we received more than four responses. All responses must include the name of the contractor, contact information, years in business, and their speciality. Positive recommendations only will be considered.*
- (c) The homeowner would be responsible for vetting the contractor, obtaining copies of their insurance and license, etc.*
- (d) The list will be maintained by our webmaster, Gerry Underwood and updated as information is received from residents.*
- (d) Once or twice a year an article be written in TT reminding the residents of this service.*
